


Version 1.01 Release Notes For PDF manuals

These notes accompany the second commercial release of RISC OS' premier design and publishing package, version 1.01.



Installation

Before installing the software, ensure that you have read and agreed with the software license agreement and limited warranty at the back of this manual before proceeding.

To install the software the **!Cerilikey** application, to be found on the 3½" floppy disc, should ideally be copied into your "Boot Resources" directory when using RISC OS 3.5 or higher. To do this, open your **!Boot** folder (usually found in the top directory of your main hard disc) by holding down **Shift** and **Select-double-clicking** on it. Now open the **Resources** directory in the filer window that has just opened and drag the **Cerilikey** application from the floppy disc into this newly opened directory. In order for Vantage to run, your personal traceable copy of **Cerilikey** needs to be seen by RISC OS beforehand. By placing it in the Boot Resources directory, you have ensured that this is the case with each future boot.

To install Vantage itself, open the Vantage CD filer window and open the vantage/arc archive using David Pilling's **SparkPlug** (supplied on the CD) or the commercial **SparkFS**. Copy **!Boot** over !Boot that may be found on your hard disc (thus giving your Boot folder Cerilica-enhanced PostScript resources) and **!DotGain**, **!Monitor** and **!Vantage** into the hard disc location of your choice. Machine re-boot is optional.

Manual

This copy of Cerilica Vantage is supplied with a manual on disc in the industry-standard PDF format. The document may therefore be viewed on both RISC OS machines and PC/Mac, etc. systems (once the PDF files have been transferred).

Under RISC OS, the premier PDF viewer — RiScript, exclusively available from Cerilica and its overseas dealers — is ideal for viewing the manual. However, consideration has been taken of other users where the manual has been designed to display correctly and fully using freeware packages such as !PDF and Adobe's Acrobat[®].

Three versions of the same manual is present on the disc, each with a different intent to allow you to use the manual as you want. the variations are described as follows:

onscreen[version].pdf	Ideal for on-screen viewing with each page presented individually and in sequence.
booklet[version].pdf	If you wish to print the whole manual as a booklet, this is the ideal file. To get a booklet result printing on a standard colour or monochrome desktop A4 printer, print the first half of the document (for example, if the PDF reader states there are a total of 116 document pages, print pages 1 to 58 inclusive). Once printed, turn the sheets over and print on the reverse side with the corresponding pages. The order you re-enter the sheets into the printer can depend on the printer and how it stacked the first set. Note that the Vantage manual is extensive so may require a large number of sheets, time and ink.
sequence[version].pdf	Again, designed for printing but more ideal for printing specific pages when required rather than the whole book as previously. All pages are in sequence with two manual

pages per document sheet.

Security system

The **!Cerilikey** security system is designed to be as unobtrusive as possible whilst allowing Cerilica to protect its large investment through years of development. If you are a pre-release user of Vantage, you will already have received and installed your unique key which allows Vantage to run. If not, please refer to the printed manual for how to install. Unlike a number of alternative software security systems, **!Cerilikey** is a separate component which may be copied direct from the floppy disc without the need to register the transfer process. Therefore if your hard disc has the misfortune to fail, it is a quick and simple operation to re-install the key without the need to contact Cerilica.

The key details the purchaser's name and address and is fully traceable.

Document recovery system

RISC OS 3.5 and higher have a memory system called "dynamic areas" built in. If available (ie. in Acorn RiscPC machines and later), Cerilica Vantage uses this system to store the document in memory allowing for very large files to be handled.

If Cerilica Vantage is unfortunate enough to unexpectedly quit, it is often possible to recover the document by loading Vantage once more. Vantage detects if a previous session has not ended correctly and provides a window in the loading process stating:

There is an unclaimed Dynamic Area called "Cerilica Vantage"

Three options are then provided: **Recover**, **Remove** and **Ignore**. By clicking on the **Recover** button, an attempt will be made to retrieve the previous session's document. If this is possible, Vantage will display the document window as normal. Please note that the document's save title will have been lost so it will be necessary to re-save the document once more in the standard RISC OS fashion.

The **Remove** option allows any "lost" data to be removed from memory thereby freeing up the amount of memory available. The loading process will continue as normal.

Finally, the **Ignore** option allows the loading process to be completed without affecting any "lost" data in the dynamic area.

Stand-alone renderer

Currently, Vantage-extended Drawfiles will load and render in existing packages such as Ovation, Impression, TechWriter, TextEase, Draw, etc. However, no new components such as graduated fills, multi-pages, transparencies or sprite fills will be reproduced on screen or print until the release of the stand-alone renderer is made available by Cerilica. This renderer will be released as soon as possible and will directly replace Acorn's original Drawfile rendering system.

When released, the renderer may be freely distributed (under strict license) to ensure all RISC OS users have access to viewing and printing Vantage-extended Drawfiles. In the meantime, direct sprite export may be used for placement within DTP packages.

PostScript/EPS output

It has to be noted that PostScript, and its derivative EPS, are currently unable to accept two key Vantage sophisticated effects; transparency and complex fills. PostScript was devised many years ago without the need or knowledge of these complex objects and is therefore not ideally suited to it.

However, as PostScript is graphics-orientated language rather than a file format, Cerilica is devising methods of generating these effects which are acceptable to image setters and PostScript interpreters. A likely outcome will be the need to convert transparent objects (and by definition, underlying objects) into appropriate resolution bitmaps whilst graduated fills may become complex vector definitions. Both solutions will greatly increase the output PostScript file size.

The current action taken by Cerilica to produce design output for magazines such as Acorn User is to generate 300dpi CMYK TIFF images directly. This produces very high quality results, even with text, and ensures correct ink usage as per **TRUISM 2** specifications and all effects are present and correct. It is also possible to thoroughly check such output with the use of Photodesk (version 2, 3 or Olympic Edition).

In a longer-term approach, the ideal vector format is PDF, especially since recent developments have allowed vector transparencies to be accommodated. Creating a dedicated PDF export mechanism will also allow for further features like interactive buttons to be catered for as well as full support for arbitrary composite inks.

Fault reporting

With a package the size and complexity of Cerilica Vantage, some users may encounter faults relating to operating the package on their system. If an error or problem occurs whilst using the package, please make use of the on-line fault report page which lists problems encountered by other users, possible solutions and fix status.

EFF Professional Font CD 2 offer

As you may be aware, most design and publishing packages are supplied with a CD full of "public domain" fonts. Cerilica considered supplying numerous RISC OS type fonts in the same manner but decided that this would be inappropriate for three reasons; (1) the legality of certain freely available fonts is questionable, (2) virtually every RISC OS user already has hundreds of free fonts and (3) the quality of free fonts is not in keeping with the professional nature of Cerilica Vantage.

Due to this reasoning, shortly before Vantage version 1.00 was finalised, Cerilica contacted The Electronic Font Foundry to ensure each Vantage customer may be supplied with EFF's second professional font CD at a discounted price of £98.50 each. The normal retail price for this product direct from EFF is over £115.00. This CD contains an astonishing 805 fonts, each individually hand-crafted for the best possible results both on and off-screen along with their PostScript Type 1 counterparts.

As a sample for the quality of EFF's fonts, a free full font family entitled LondonA is included on the Vantage CD.
